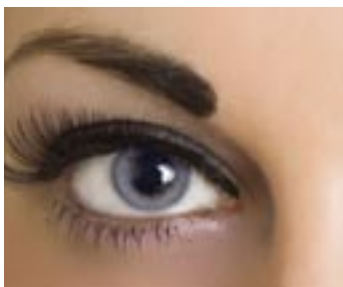

EYELASHES

Lash extensions are one of the newest innovations in the quest for luscious lashes. To lengthen and/or give volume, fibre lashes are woven and glued into your own lash line, so they will gradually fall out with the natural growth of your lashes - around 4 to 6 weeks. My first bout with lash extensions left me looking like Betty Boop; they were long, sweeping and effortlessly fluttered in a most seductive way, but I felt very self conscious. After 4 weeks, I returned and asked for a more realistic length and a concentration of volume. This was much more satisfactory and lasted 6 weeks. For those desperately seeking the flutter, ask for volume and realise this is a temporary solution, but one that is very good for a special occasion, such as your wedding and honeymoon.
